

ORDINANCE NO. 941
ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 89, PARKS,
PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, IN THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey that Sections 89-12 and 89-26 of Chapter 89, Parks, Playgrounds and Recreational Facilities, are hereby amended in the Code of the Borough of Barrington, as follows:

ARTICLE I. ARTICLE III. SECTION 89-12 Restricted substances.

Alcoholic beverages may be used in recreation areas or parks with a permit obtained from the municipal governing body subject to the New Jersey Alcoholic Beverages Law.

ARTICLE II. ARTICLE III. SECTION 89-26 Restricted substances.

While in a public park or recreation area, all persons shall conduct themselves in a proper and orderly manner, and in particular, no person shall:

A. Bring alcoholic beverages or drink same in recreation areas or parks, without a permit obtained from the municipal governing body;

B. through K. Sections B. through K. are retained in their entirety.

ARTICLE III.

All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

ARTICLE IV.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
