Project: I-295 Gloucester / Camden Rehabilitation

Nature of work: Road & Bridge construction – Implement **Stage 5 in Work Zone 2**
with the work zone moving from the NB roadway to the SB roadway.

Anticipated Traffic Impacts (in Work Zone 2):

Currently (Stage 4), the work zone is on the left side of the NB roadway with a NB
contraflow lane maintained on the SB side of the road.

Temporary nighttime lane closures to implement the new traffic pattern.

Stage 5 traffic pattern on I-295 NB – Three NB lanes of traffic will be maintained
shifted to the right.

Stage 5 traffic pattern on I-295 SB – Two lanes of SB traffic shifted to the left and one
SB contraflow lane maintained on the NB side of the roadway for a total of three SB
lanes. The work zone will be on the right side of the SB roadway.

Description of New Traffic Pattern (in Work Zone 2):

Three lanes of I-295 NB traffic will be maintained on the NB roadway, shifted to the
right and a SB contraflow lane will be established on the NB side of the roadway.

I-295 SB traffic will be shifted to the left maintaining two lanes on the SB roadway and
one contraflow lane on the NB side of I-295 for a total of three SB lanes. The work zone
will be on the right side of I-295 SB (right lane and shoulder) defined with concrete
construction barrier.
