

**RESOLUTION NO. 1-2009-10**

**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING OFFICIAL NEWSPAPERS FOR 2009 IN COMPLIANCE WITH  
THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, CHAPTER 231, P.L 1975**

**WHEREAS**, Section 3D of the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 231 P.L. 1975 requires that certain notice of meetings be submitted to two (2) newspapers, one of which shall be the Official Newspaper; and

**WHEREAS**, these newspapers designated by this body must be the ones which have the greatest likelihood of informing the Public within the jurisdictional boundaries of this body of such meeting;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Retrospect Newspaper of 732 Haddon Avenue, Collingswood, New Jersey, the Courier Post Newspaper located at Cuthbert Boulevard and Hampton Road, Cherry Hill, New Jersey, and the Philadelphia Inquirer, South Jersey Edition, are hereby designated to receive all notices of meetings as required under the Open Public Meetings Act.
2. It is the opinion of this body that the Retrospect Newspaper, the Courier Post and the Inquirer have the greatest likelihood of informing the public within the jurisdictional area of this body of such meeting.
3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
