

RESOLUTION 4-2010-34

AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, adoption of the 2010 Municipal Budget has been delayed pending the outcome of the Borough's application to the State of New Jersey for extraordinary aid; and

WHEREAS, no provision was made in the 2010 Temporary Budget for budget appropriations beyond March 31, 2010; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency temporary appropriation for operating expenditures when the adoption of the Municipal Budget has been delayed; and

WHEREAS, the total emergency operating expenditures for the second quarter of 2010 are expected to be \$ 1,387,301.31 for the Current Fund and \$ 138,979.77 for the Sewer Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington in accordance with the provisions of NJSA 40A:4-20 that:

1. An emergency temporary appropriation in the amount of \$ 1,387,301.31 for the Current Fund and \$ 138,979.77 for the Sewer Fund is hereby made.
2. That said emergency temporary appropriations have been provided for in the 2010 Municipal Budget.
