

RESOLUTION 4-2011-40

Authorizing a Shared Service Agreement for Fire Marshal Services

WHEREAS the County of Camden ceased to provide Fire Marshal services as of April 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS the Boroughs of Barrington, Hi-Nella, Lawnside, Magnolia, Mount Ephraim and Oaklyn desire to enter into a shared service agreement for Fire Marshal services with Barrington as the lead agency; and

WHEREAS the name of the Local Enforcing Agency created by the shared service agreement shall be the Regional Fire Prevention Alliance; and

WHEREAS the terms of the agreement have been resolved and memorialized in the shared service agreement annexed hereto which has been approved by all of the participating municipalities;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington that a shared service agreement for Fire Marshal services with the Boroughs of Hi-Nella, Lawnside, Magnolia, Mount Ephraim and Oaklyn, with Barrington as the lead agency, is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute any and all documents related thereto.
