

RESOLUTION 4-2011-42
Approving Waiving of Construction Permit Fees

WHEREAS Barrington resident Casey Umba has an extraordinarily rare illness that requires construction of handicapped accessible accommodations at his home; and

WHEREAS the Borough has been asked to consider waiving the construction permit fees for the construction of handicapped accessible accommodations due to the financial burden and the extraordinary and rare nature of Casey's illness; and

WHEREAS the governing body desires to help in this capacity;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington that the local construction permit fees relative to the construction of handicapped accessible accommodations at the home of Casey Umba be waived; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the waiving of said fees shall apply only to the local fees normally charged and shall not apply to any fees that are collected and paid to the State of New Jersey.
