RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REPROGRAMMING OF FY2010 (YEAR 32) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Barrington received grant funds from the Camden County Community Block Grant (CDBG) Program in the amount of \$36,180 for FY2010 (Year 32); and

WHEREAS, the funds were originally allocated to street improvements along Trenton, Haines, Austin and Reading Avenues; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that these streets do not meet the required criteria to qualify for CDBG funding and the funds would be better utilized for street and curb improvements in the Stoneybrook Development which is an eligible area; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held to discuss the reallocation of the FY2010 (Year 32) funds; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body does desire to reprogram the FY2010 (Year 32) funds to street and curb improvements in the Stoneybrook Development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the Borough of Barrington hereby requests that FY2010 (Year 32) funds in the amount of \$36,180 be reprogrammed from street improvements along Trenton, Haines, Austin and Reading Avenues to street and curb improvements in the Stoneybrook Development; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Camden County Community Development Office so this formal request can be processed and approved.
